Welcome back Friends

April showers...bring May flowers **AND** riders plus their guests. If you haven't been here for awhile, don't forget to...

- Strap Your Helmet Riders are al-ways seen on camp roads and on the trails with the straps to their helmet hanging undone. If something would happen that you were thrown from your machine, the strap is what keeps the helmet on your head! Don't be fooled by thinking you're ok to wear your helmet unstrapped in the parking lot because there have been accidents on camp roads and while loading and unloading machines in the parking lots too. STRAP IT TIGHT!!
- Sign In & Print Neatly Too—Sign in upon arrival including and especially non riders/campsite guests or guest riders. There are two different clipboards ALWAYS hanging on the outside wall of the office, 24 hours a day. Please print neatly so that we know who you are!
- Go Over Your Machine-put fresh gas and new spark plug in your machine and just to be on the safe side check your battery. You don't want to be broken down out in the trails on your first adventure of the year.
- Don't Forget to Bring that Cell Phone & program our # in it (570-682-1075) just in case there's an emergency.
