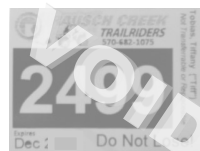

TIP OF THE DAY

SALTED CARAMEL HOT COCOA MIX

2 1/2 c. sugar—1 1/4 c. water—2 Tbsp vanilla extract— 1 1/2 c. cocoa —2 Tbsp sea salt —1 c. dry milk powder—3/4 c. brown sugar—10 oz. bittersweet chocolate chips

In a medium saucepan, combine the water and sugar. Heat over medium heat until boiling, stirring to dissolve the sugar. Brush down the sides with a damp pastry brush to avoid sugar crystals, and stop stirring. Cook until the caramel is a dark amber color (not stirring), swirling every so often. Remove from heat, and stir in the vanilla (careful - it will bubble violently). Pour the caramel onto a parchment lined baking sheet to harden (at least an hour). Once caramel is cool, break into pieces, and place in a food processor. Pulverize the caramel into a fine powder. Add the cocoa, sea salt, dry milk powder, and coconut sugar. Process until well mixed. Add in the chocolate, and process until mixture is a fine powder. Put mix into pint size mason jars. To make hot cocoa, stir 3 tbsp of mix into 8 oz. of hot milk or water.
