TIP OF THE DAY

No matter how many times I set out to hard boil eggs, I almost never remember how to do it the next time. And there's nothing worse than cracking open an egg only to find the yolk hasn't been cooked enough. Here's a classic method for hard boiling eggs in case you have eggs yet to dye too. Directions for Large Eggs: 1. Place eggs in a saucepan with enough COLD tap water to cover completely by 1". Bring to a ROLLING boil over HIGH heat. PROMPTLY reduce heat to a lower medium boil and cook an additional 10 minutes for a "hard boiled" egg. 2. Remove from heat and IMMEDIATELY place eggs under ice cold water or in a bowl of ICED water to chill promptly to help yolks stay bright yellow. Chill for a few minutes in the cold water until the egg is completely cooled. This is an extremely important step which prevents the greenish "ring" from forming on the surface of the yolk over time. Refrigerated boiled eggs, kept in the shell, can be kept for up to 1 week.

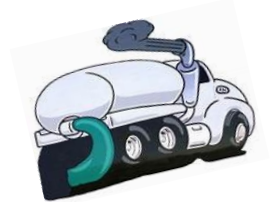
