## DUMPSTER Etiquette



The rules pertaining to what you can toss in your trash can are the same guidelines to follow when using Rausch Creek dumpster. These rules are in place for environmental reasons as well as local and state regulations related to waste disposal. Our waste management service does not want to climb in our dumpsters every week to find something not within the guidelines. There is a courtesy two trash bag limit per campsite per weekend. Some have taken full advantage causing an avalanche of trash!

### GUIDELINES

2 bag limit per campsite

NO TIRES, HazMat Waste, Appliances, Electronics or Metal

NO building materials —like old decks or shingles

## BURN BAN CAUTION

Small campfires are permitted only where adequate precautions are being taken due to many wild fires in the area. All other fires are prohibited.

NEVER leave a campfire unattended.

**\*\*Have you noticed the sign letting you know the status of the burn ban?** They are posted at each camp gate.

Obviously **RED** means no burning & **YELLOW** means small fires permitted.



# TIP OF THE DAY

## Baking Soda?

Eliminate the gaseous side effects of baked beans by adding a dash of baking soda while cooking.

Keep cauliflower white and its odor under control when boiling or steaming by adding 1 tsp of baking soda to cooking water.

Add a pinch of baking soda to the water when boiling cabbage to tenderize and avoid overcooking.

A pinch of baking soda thrown into potatoes while mashing will make them fluffier.

Test the freshness of baking soda by pouring a small amount of white vinegar or lemon juice over 1/2 tsp of baking soda. If it doesn't actively bubble, it's too old to use.
