***The race area** — Friday- Sunday afternoon **will have restrictions.** A map will be posted at the office.

*You can come and watch too! As long as you sign in at the office as usual and wear your helmet sticker as always.

*For the safety of the competitors and

yourself, it is very important that you **AVOID** any course markings such as caution tape, wooden stakes and arrows. Especially in the case of the yellow tape, even the simple act of raising a section to ride under it can stretch or rip down the only thing that we have to communicate to racers of the presence of dangerous obstacles. Under no circumstances may you ride on the actual course until the day after the event. This holds true during setup the week leading up and especially race day.
