



HARESCRAMBLE COMING SOON!!

After almost 12 years without a race hosted at Rausch Creek we are excited to bring you one. The SPER Hare Scramble race on June 28th and 29th **AND THERE WILL BE TRAILS CLOSURES.**

Here's what the members need to know: The Youth Hare Scrambles will be hosted on Saturday, June 28th (Race Day #1 starting noon-5pm). The Main Hare Scramble will be hosted on SUNDAY, June 29th (Race Day #2 starting at 10am-4pm).

The race area —**all trails East of the 1-2 split CLOSED, South of Gap Street/the railroad tracks CLOSED.**

Members can ride Trail #1 but no further East of the mine shaft trail entrance. The above mentioned closed trails will CLOSE Friday-Sunday afternoon. This does not mean you have no trails to ride.

A map will be posted at the office. Members can spectate but unfortunately must park machines and walk to the race course.

Any member wanting to watch the start or be in the pit area (the Rally Bear Valley field) will be required to enter by regular vehicle at the Summit Coal haul road near Joliett; sign the waiver and pay \$10 per person. Unfortunately, there is no other way to safely reach that location without interfering with the event.

For the safety of the competitors and yourself, it is very important that you AVOID any course markings such as caution tape, wooden stakes and arrows. Especially in the case of the yellow tape, even the simple act of raising a section to ride under it can stretch or rip down the only thing that we have to communicate to racers of the presence of dangerous obstacles.

Under no circumstances may you ride on the actual course until the day after the event.

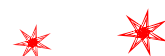
