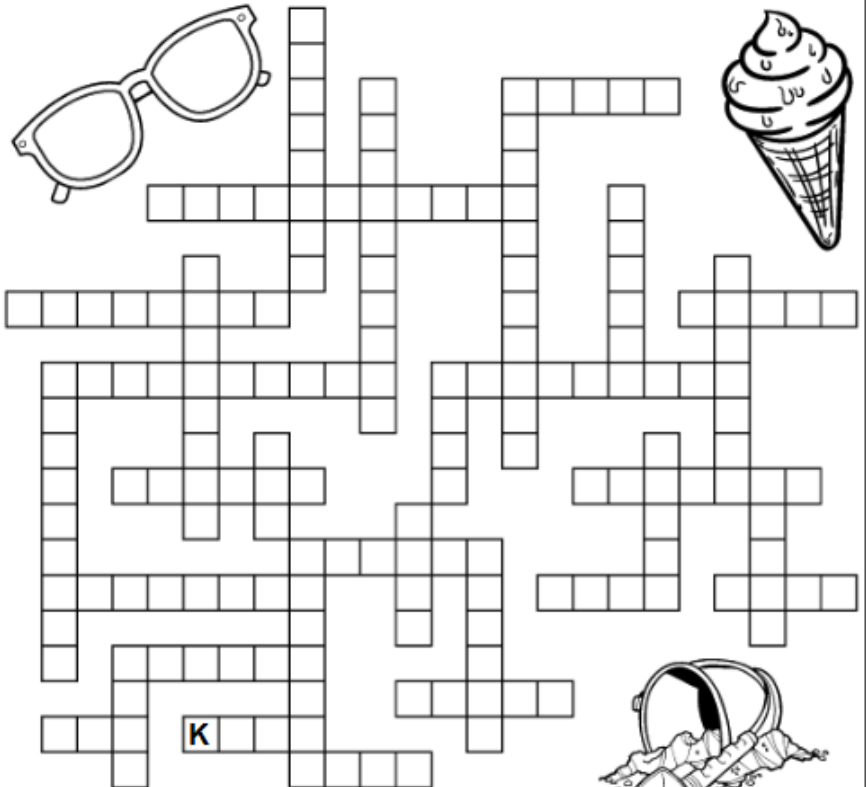
MUD RUN
