No riding before 9:00 AM from October 4, 2025 – January 19, 2026

No riding before 9:00 AM on Sundays from October 5 – December 7, 2025

Special Restrictions:

No riding until NOON

Saturday, October 18 – Black Bear & Deer

No riding ALL DAY

Thursday, October 23 – Deer (Junior/Senior)

Monday, November 24 – Black Bear

Saturday, November 29 – Deer (Buck)
