JUST a reminder ABOUT THE LIMITATIONS for access to **Trail 7** and ALL PROPERTY SOUTH OF ROUTE 209. THE 4X4 PARK, WHICH HOLDS a LEASE ON MUCH OF IT, IS CONTINUING TO HONOR THE AGREEMENT WE MADE AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR BY ONLY USING OUR PROPERTY ON SCHEDULED DAYS, JUST AS WE AGREED. ALL POLICIES AND PROCEDURES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- ONLY THE POSTED SCHEDULED GUIDED ONLY RIDES ON **Trail 7** are PERMITTED across ROUTE 209.
- ANY MEMBER CAUGHT RIDING TRAIL 7 WITHOUT a GUIDE WILL BE SUSPENDED.
- NO OTHER RIDING SOUTH OF ROUTE 209- LIKE SCOUTING, ETC. IS PERMITTED UNLESS SPECIFICALLY ARRANGED IN ADVANCE BY NICK OR TIFFANY
- THE LAST TRAIL 7 RIDE IS ON NOVEMBER 17...THE "TURKEY" RIDE. FIND THE HIDDEN TURKEY AND WIN a PRIZE FROM THE OFFICE.

TIP OF THE DAY

Line Your Gloves and Boots with Hand Warmers Before Bed

Pop a couple of air-activated hand warmers into your gloves and boots *before* you go to sleep. This keeps them from getting stiff, damp, or icy overnight—so when you gear up in the morning, everything's warm and ready to go.
