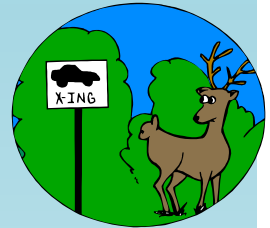
CLOSED TO ALL RIDING SATURDAY!

Facts OF THE DAY

The one consolation of the encroaching winter chill is that, finally, it's the time of year when you can stoke up a fire, but it's no fun if you're not fully equipped. Start with wood; dry hardwood such as hickory, ash, oak, maple, and birch are all good choices. If you see radial cracks along the cross section of a hardwood log, you'll know it's dry enough to use. Avoid burning softwoods like pine or spruce, as they tend to burn up too quickly, and be certain to store your wood in a cool, dry place. To get the blaze going, you'll also need kindling--small twigs & twisted newspaper are perfect. Some great aromatic items to throw on the flame could be pine cones and lavender.
