



A Beautiful Winter Wonderland @ RCTR

We're heading into a true winter weekend. Saturday will stay cold, with temperatures below freezing and a chance for light snow or flurries throughout the day.

A larger winter system — unofficially dubbed Winter Storm Fern — is expected to move in Sunday into Monday. While exact snowfall totals won't be known until it arrives, forecasters agree we'll see accumulating snow and continued frigid temperatures. Whatever falls should provide some cushion on the trails and a classic winter riding feel.

With PennDOT restricting certain vehicles on the highways as the winter storm moves in, the office will be closed on Sunday. For everyone's safety, we are strongly discouraging travel to the property during the storm. Conditions are expected to deteriorate quickly, and access in or out may become limited. If you were planning to come to the campground, please wrap up your visit on Saturday and avoid traveling to Trailriders until conditions improve after the storm. We want all members to stay safe and avoid getting stuck on the roads or on the mountain.

Beginning Saturday night into Sunday, towing a trailer without a four wheel drive vehicle is not recommended until conditions improve. Camp roads will be minimally plowed, so please plan accordingly and bring a shovel.

Trails should be manageable, but ride at your own risk. Snow depth and drifting will vary between Saturday's light activity and the Sunday-Monday storm. Because of past recoveries in similar conditions, we are requiring the Buddy System for the next few weeks or until the snow begins to dissipate. All riders must be accompanied by another member or friend. A shovel should be on your packing list.

Stay prepared, ride smart, and respect the winter conditions out there.



FROZEN %\$@

Unfortunately, most members who signed up for septic service are experiencing frozen tanks due to the recent temperatures. The septic service will continue to run on a two week schedule until spring, at which point it will return to weekly service (next service on 2/5). Please notify the office if you manage to unthaw your system before spring and the septic service will be happy to service your potty or RV.

Please follow the steps below to help prevent this issue in the future. These steps should be started each October and continued through winter:

- Pour one cup of RV antifreeze and one cup of rock salt into the toilet bowl. Use one cup for every 5–6 gallons of water the toilet bowl holds.



- For RV flush toilets, flush so the antifreeze moves into the holding tank and through the pipes. Add an additional half cup of rock salt into the toilet and flush it down into the tank.

These steps help reduce the chance of freezing during extreme cold spells.
