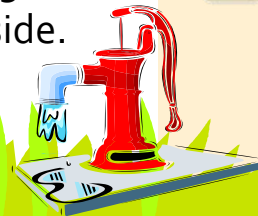

Take your trash will you. Don't leave it laying all around the shed.

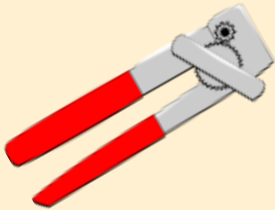
The pump house has finally reopened after a long cold first half of the season.
