Campfire Safety

With the holiday weekend rolling in, many of us picture the classic camping scene — a warm fire, a few marshmallows, and that perfect crackling soundtrack under the stars. Campfires bring heat, light, cooking, and a great place to swap stories.

But with the temperatures expected to climb, who knows how many folks will even bother lighting one. If you do, here are a few simple safety reminders to keep your campsite and family protected:

Clear the Area — Clean out an 8–10 ft radius around your fire site so nothing nearby can ignite.

Contain the Fire — Use a burn barrel, grill, or a solid rock ring to keep flames controlled.

Keep It Small — A small fire is safer, easier to manage, and just as enjoyable.

Have Water Ready — Keep water nearby and a shovel handy to throw sand or dirt if needed.

Store Wood Safely — Stack extra firewood upwind and away from the flames.

Cool Your Matches — Make sure matches are completely cold before tossing them or just toss them right into the fire pit.

Never Leave It Unattended — Even a tiny breeze can spread embers quickly.

Extinguish Thoroughly — Drown the fire with water until all coals, sticks, and embers are soaked.

Don't Bury Coals — Buried embers can smolder and reignite.

Teach Kids Fire Respect — Make sure little ones understand fire safety and boundaries.
