September Reset at RCTR

September brings a shift — cooler mornings, fall routines and a busy holiday weekend ahead. As we head into Labor Day, here's your quick reset to keep the campground safe, smooth, and enjoyable for everyone.

With extra riders, evening traffic, and larger groups visiting, awareness and courtesy make all the difference. Please take a moment to review the guidelines below.

Weekend Focus: Traffic

Holiday weekends bring heavier movement between campsites, especially after dark. Please slow down, stay alert, and keep headlights on when traveling through the campground.

Campground Rules & Reminders

Guest Sign-In

- Campsites with **10+ guests** must email a list to trailriders@rauschcreekracing.com.
- Unregistered guests will be asked to leave.

Speed Limit

- **5 MPH** at all times.
- Speeding = parked for the weekend.

Minor Riders

- Riders **12 & under** must be supervised.
- Unsupervised riding = parked.
- No campground laps — use the **kiddie track**.

Quiet Time

- **10:30 PM - 7:00 AM**
- Keep voices and music at a respectful level.

Helmet Rules

- Helmets must be **worn and strapped** when loading, unloading, riding in the campground, or moving machines around campsites.

General Courtesy

- Expect increased traffic on weekends/holidays.
- Stay alert when moving between campsites, especially after dark.
- Keep campsites clean and follow posted signs and staff instructions.

Labor Day became a federal holiday in 1894, signed into law by President Grover Cleveland just six days after the end of the Pullman Strike.

The first Labor Day was celebrated on September 5, 1882, in New York City, when over 10,000 workers marched from City Hall to Union Square.

The "no white after Labor Day" fashion rule became a popular tradition in the mid-20th century, marking Labor Day as the unofficial end of summer.
