## Implement Rules

It's time to get serious! We are very busy and getting fed up with nonsense. Please review the following bullet points of new & not so new implemented rules:

- Guest/visitor sign-in will be enforced. Any campsite who plans to have 10 or more guests must provide a list of guests names to the office by emailing trailriders@rauschcreekracing.com (3 days before arrival). Staff will be making sure this rule is being enforced and checking campsites. If a guest is not signed in, they will have the pleasure of driving home immediately. This is no joke! The days of having guests drive in unattended or not signed in are over.
- Campground speed limit is 5mph, you will be parked if this is violated.
- Any minor rider, 12 & under, riding through the campground without adult supervision will be escorted back to their camp...continuous disregard for this rule will result in the parking of your child for the remainder of the weekend. The campground is full. As a courtesy, to other campers, we will no longer allow youth riders to use the campground as a riding area. There are areas like the kiddie track where kids can ride with adult supervision. The days of letting kids loose in the campground or even near your campsite are over.
- Noise complaints are abundant this year! No one expects you to be quiet as a mouse. Respect others by *lowering voices and music during quiet hours 10pm-7am...*voices and music carry in the still of night, so be
