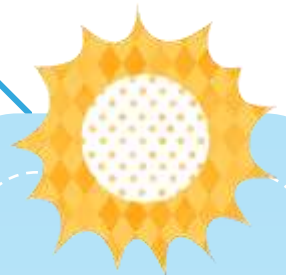

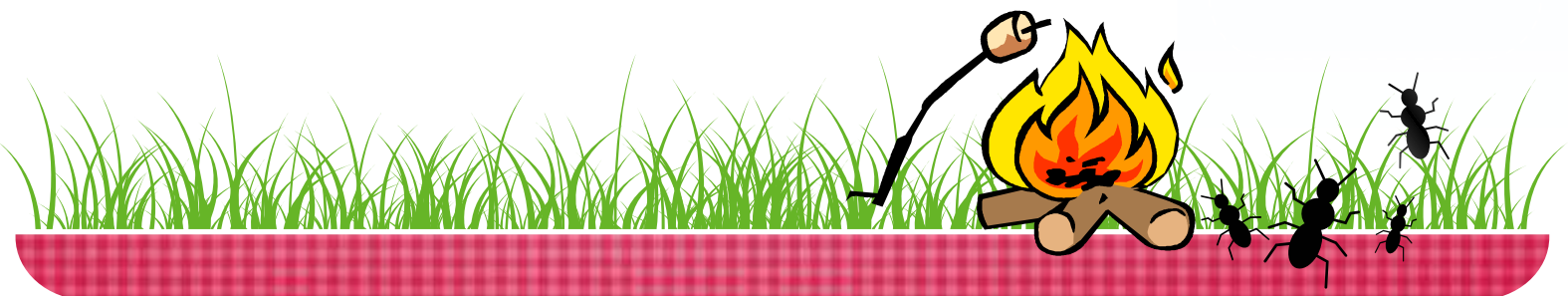
Bonfire Bash

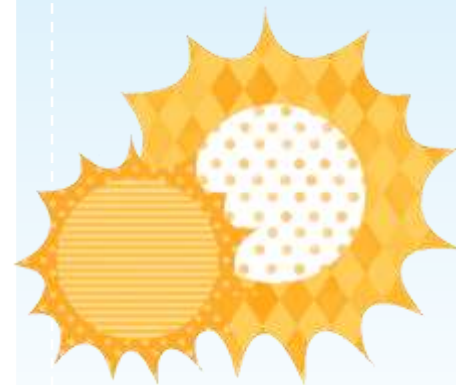
