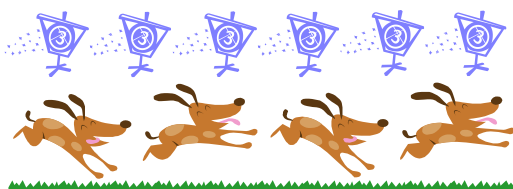

IT'S GOING TO BE A BUSY WEEKEND

Lets make sure everyone can have an enjoyable holiday by remembering a few basics:

⌚ **Stop and Sign-In Always!** The clipboard is outside the office, 24/7.

⌚ **5mph on ALL campground roads**

⌚ **Quiet Time is 10PM to 7AM in the campground.** If you have a loud generator running, please make sure it gets turned off. If you're having a party, please make sure things quiet down by 10PM.

⌚ **Campfires Only, NOT BONFIRES!** Please keep your campfire to a reasonable size and make sure all leaves and other debris are cleared from around the campfire ring before starting the fire AND NEVER leave a campfire burning unattended.

⌚ **No fireworks of any kind are permitted.** It's Pennsylvania State Law.

⌚ **Don't ride down the Township Road** (only in an emer-

gency). Please use trail crossings.

⌚ **If you see someone stopped** along the side of the trail, stop and make sure they're ok.

⌚ **Watch out for the KIDDIES!** Many families with small children will be camping and riding at RCTR this weekend. Be extra cautious and give these little ones plenty of leeway.

⌚ **Take your cell phone** with you when you ride. You may need it in an emergency. P.S. The office phone number is on your helmet sticker.

⌚ **Head back** at least 30 minutes before dark.
