TIP OF THE DAY

Strawberry Jam Bars

32 servings, one triangle each



1-1/4 cups flour 1-1/4 cups firmly packed light brown

sugar, divided 3/4 cup (1-1/2 sticks) butter, softened 2 cups whole grain cereal flakes with pecans 1 pkg. (8 oz.) PHILADELPHIA Cream Cheese, softened 1 egg 3/4 cup strawberry jam PREHEAT oven to 350°F. Mix flour and 1 cup of the sugar in large bowl. Add butter; mix until crumbly. Stir in cereal. PRESS about 3 cups of the cereal mixture firmly onto bottom of greased 13x9-inch baking pan. Mix cream cheese, remaining 1/4 cup sugar and the egg in small bowl until blended; spread evenly over crust. Top with layers of jam and the remaining cereal mixture. **BAKE** 25 to 30 min. or until lightly browned. Cool completely on wire rack. Cut into triangles or bars.
