## The Looong Weekend...

Lets make sure everyone can enjoy the **last holiday weekend of the Summer by** the campfire ring before starting the fire. keeping in a mind a few basics:

TWO NO-NO's the Office Keeps Needing to address with members:

No Metal or Plastic Sheds —they become trash disposal after trees find them

No metal chains—only plastic—no rope going across campsites... – possible choking/decapitation hazards after someone runs into them while riding

**Stop and Sign-In Always!** The clipboard is outside the office, 24/7, including those visitors to your camp.

**Sommet 5** 5 mph on ALL campground roads

**©Ouiet Time is 10:30PM to 6AM in the** campground this weekend. If you have a loud generator running, please make sure it gets turned off on time. If you're having a party, please make sure things quiet down by 10:30PM.

## **©Campfires Only, NOT BONFIRES!**

Please keep your campfire at a reasonable size and make sure all leaves and other debris are cleared from around **NEVER** leave a campfire burning unattended.

**No fireworks of any kind are** permitted. It's Pennsylvania State Law.

©Don't ride down the Township Road. Please use trail crossings.

**If you see someone stopped** along the side of the trail, stop and make sure they're ok.

**Watch out for the KIDDIES!** Many families with small children will be camping and riding at RCTR this weekend. Be extra cautious and give these little ones plenty of leeway.

**Take your cell phone** with you when you ride. You may need it to call in an emergency. P.S. The office phone number is on your helmet sticker.

If you break down, get a flat tire, or even run out of gas and need a tow, the office is here to help; give us a call.

**Shead back at least 30 minutes before** dark.

## TIP OF THE DAY

Ways to Use Old Coffee Grounds

Deodorizer-Place used grounds on a cookie sheet to dry. Keep in a bowl in your refrigerator or freezer, or rub them onto your hands to get rid of odors. Also, fill old panty hose and hang in your closet to fight odors.

Plant Food – Plants that like acidic soil, such as rosebushes, azaleas, rhododendrons, evergreens and camellias benefit from the coffee ground.

Kitty Repellent – to keep kitty from using the garden as its personal powder room, sprinkle coffee grounds mixed with orange peels around your plants.

Insect Repellent – Sprinkle old grounds around places you don't want ants, or directly on ant-hills. Use grounds also to repel snails and snugs.

Dust Controller – When cleaning out the fireplace, throw a good amount of wet coffee grounds over the ashes to keep the dust from spreading.
