## Tip of the Day!

With all the is rain...do they make Mini Rain Gutters for your RV? I don't know but I did find a tip on how to make your own. Use J-Channel to create miniature rain gutters on the sides of your RV. This material is normally placed around residential windows during vinyl siding installation, can be obtained at large hardware stores.

To modify the j-channel, use tin snips to remove the strip with nail holes. Next remove the factoryinstalled flexible plastic trim that run across the top edges of each side of my RV. Install the jchannel with screws approximately every 6 inches.

Block off the opening of these channels to whichever direction you need the water runoff to go. To prevent possible water leaks into the roof structure of the RV, use silicone sealant to seal all

exposed screw heads.
