Neither <u>sky-high airfares nor \$5-a-gallon gasoline prices</u> will keep Americans from getting away for July Fourth, according to the American Automobile Association (AAA). The auto club is predicting that 47.9 million people will travel over the holiday weekend, including a record 42 million road trippers. That's slightly more than the 41.4 million Americans who traveled by car over Independence Day weekend in 2019. Escaping a city? Expect high levels of congestion on the afternoons on Thursday, June 30 and Friday, July 1 as commuters leave work early and mix with holiday travelers. Drivers in major U.S. metros could experience double the travel times compared to a normal trip, says AAA. Avoid all that city non-sense and relax/slow down at RCTR. To keep
