Labor Day is the symbolic end of summer. It's the last three-day weekend for a while; the beginning of the NFL and college football seasons; the last gasp of school vacation for many; and the last day of the year for white shoes, for those that still hold to that moldy fashion rule. A million barbeque grills will be lit this weekend, while in some places the leaves are already turning. Lets make sure everyone can enjoy the last holiday weekend of the Summer by keeping in a mind a few **Ruics:**

- Guest/visitor sign-in- Any campsite who plans to have 10 or more guests must provide a list of guests names to the office by emailing trailriders@rauschcreekracing.com. If a guest is not signed in, they will have the pleasure of driving home immediately. The days of having guests drive around unattended is no longer permitted.
- Campground speed limit is 5mph, you will be parked if this is violated.
- Any minor rider, 12 & under, riding through the campground without adult supervision will be escorted back to their camp...continuous disregard for this rule will result in the parking of your

child for the remainder of the weekend. The campground is full. As a courtesy, to other campers, please do not have your child do continuous lap after lap in the campground. There are areas like the kiddie track where kids can ride with adult supervision.

- Quiet Time extended 10:30pm-7AM in the campground. Noise complaints haven't been toto bad this year but it is still happening! No one expects you to be quiet as a mouse. Respect others by lowering voices and music during quiet hours 10pm-7am (this weekend
- 10:30pm)...voices and music carry in the still of night, so be respectful of this time. This goes for daytime as well. Keep it to a respectable level or it's going to be NO LEVEL.
- Review the helmet rules. Helmets must be worn & properly strapped at all times. This includes while loading and unloading, riding in the campground or just moving it around in your campsite. The only partial exception applies to UTV's with built-in full rollover protection.
- •With the Labor Day holiday approaching, keep in mind that the campground will be quite busy. Please use extra care, when commuting from campsite to campsite particularly during evening time hours. Let's not make this privilege turn into a new restriction.
