For new members or those who haven't participated in the cleanup in past years, make sure to join us at the pavilion around 9am on Saturday, April 22nd.

There will be a place to park your bike or quad while you are taken out to the roads leading to Rausch Creek. The Adopt-a-Highway program is gracious enough to provide everyone with gloves, safety vests, and a bunch of trash bags. Get ready to be loaded into a pickup truck and taken out to pick up all the litter from the past year along the road. Families with small children can clean the camp roads and township road.

The more people we get to participate, the faster the process goes, the quicker we get to eat and hit the trailhead. So please participate! It is so appreciated. The event usually finishes up around noon. Expect to only be on the road for about a 1/2 hour depending on the participation we have.

All trails will be CLOSED until the cleanup is over.
